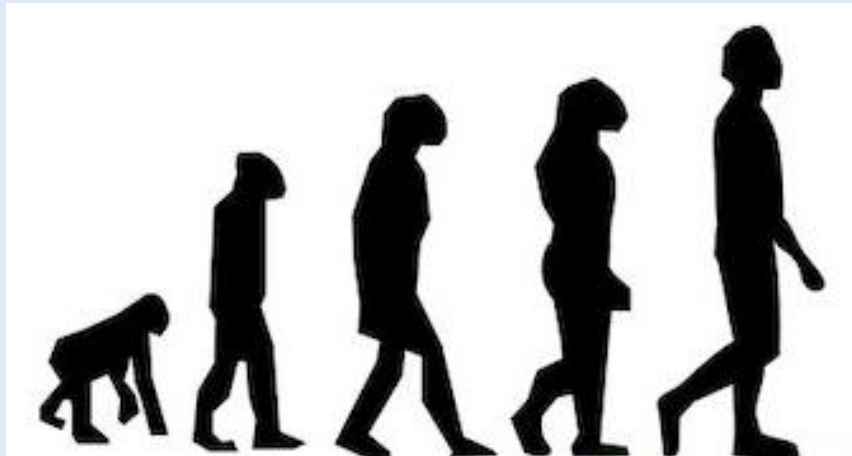
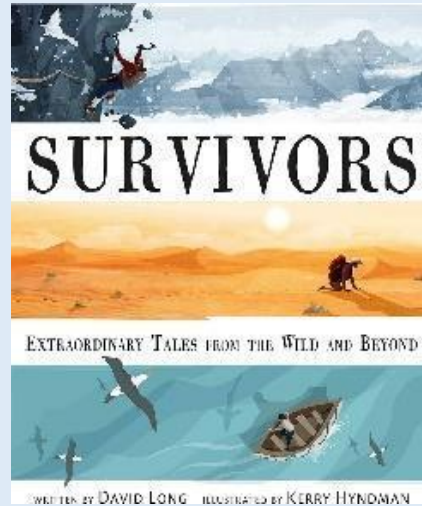


**Binstead Primary School Curriculum**

## Mathematics
