



Dear Families,

I cannot quite believe we are at the end of another week again. It has been lovely to see so much brilliant work happening both in school and at home, and also hearing about the fun times everyone is still managing to have too.

Yesterday the Government's guidance for September was released (well, version 1 at least), and we will take our time to digest and come up with the best plan possible for our children, families and staff. I am so pleased to see, however, that the plan is for ALL children to return to school in September. We have missed the children greatly who have not been able to come in, and cannot wait to see them all again in September. As soon as the plan has been put together and approved by the school's Governors, I will share it with you. Please bear with us, as you have done with previous guidance, as we want to take our time to get it right, and to ensure our children can return safely to school.

We are currently preparing your child's school report, and going round the school to collect up things that were left on the 20th March, all those months ago. Due to ensuring there is a reduced amount of adults around the school site, we have allocated slots for you to come and collect your child's report and belongings. These will be available from the front office, please observe social distancing when entering the building, only one person at a time may enter the foyer. If possible we would ask that only one adult comes to collect. If you have more than one child in school, your children's reports and belongings will be available in the time slot for your **YOUNGEST** sibling.

The time slots are as follows:

Monday 13th July – All children IN school will take theirs home.

Monday 13th July 9.20 – 12pm Year 2

Monday 13th July 1pm – 2.15pm Year 3

Tuesday 14th July 9.20am – 12pm Year 4

Tuesday 14th July 1pm – 2.15 Year 5

Wednesday 15th July 9.20 – 12pm Year 6

Wednesday 15th July 1pm – 2.15pm Any Reception or Year 1 who ARE NOT in school.

If you wish to collect your child's report, rather than it be given to them, please contact the office to arrange a suitable time for collection.

This week I have applied to the Local Authority to have the 1st September (Tuesday) as the first INSET day of the school year. As soon as I have this confirmed as approved, I will let you know. I just wanted to give you advanced notice of our intention.
